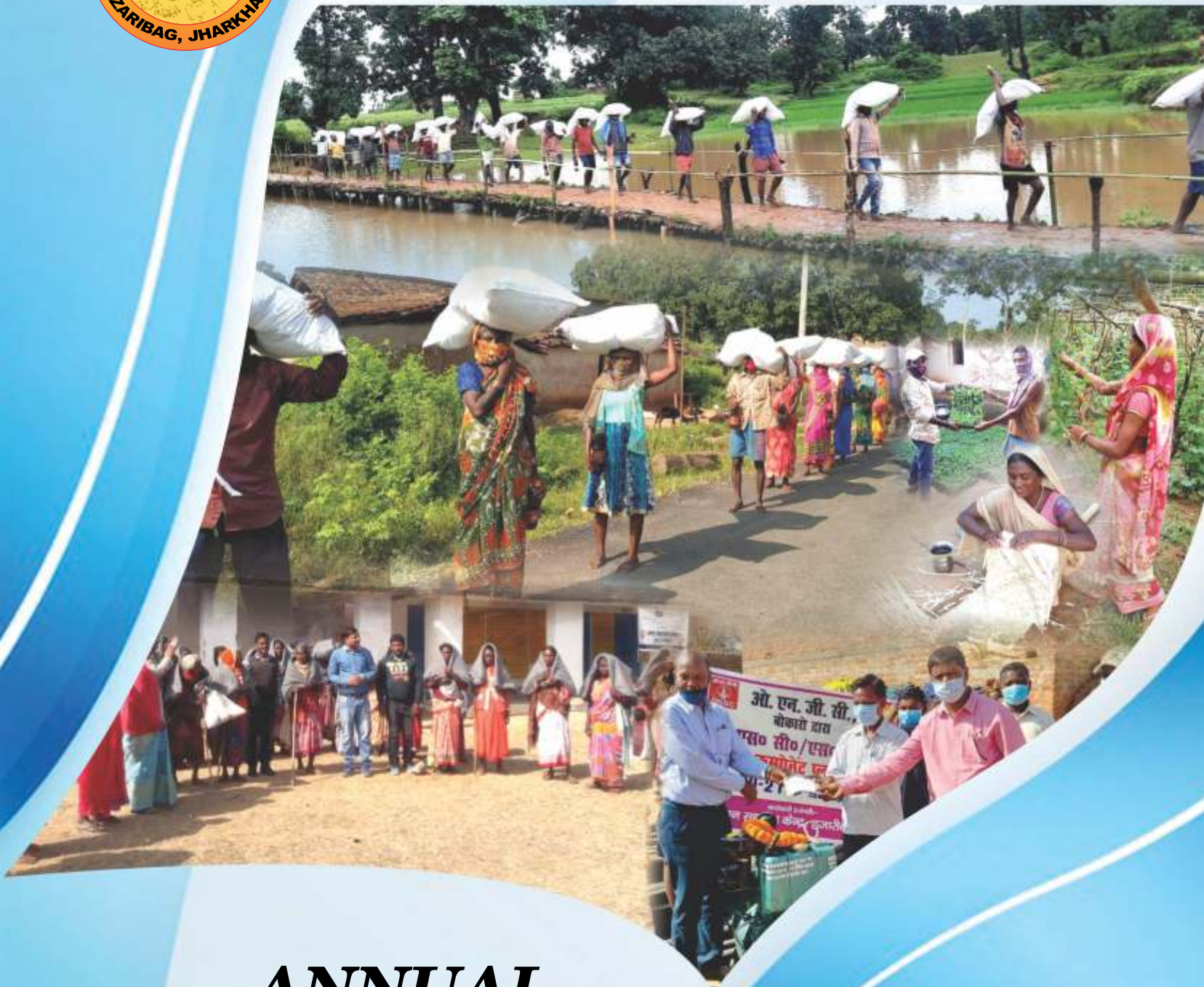

From the Desk of *Secretary*



It is pride to present our annual report of Year 2020-21. We have been completed 18th Years in development field. Our efforts contributed us to achieve the vision and mission of our organization. We worked on many activities including women empowerment, children education, Health issues, Natural Resource development, water Sources, etc. We tried our best to deliver the optimum benefits to the poor and needy target population. JSK believe in community participation and involving the community in our work for full community ownership.

This year our main focus was on relief to Covid Victim and provide livelihood opportunities during the pandemic in Bokaro, Chatra and Hazaribag districts of Jharkhand. Many families lost their earning member and their livelihood due to Covid. Many Migrant labouers came to big cities due to lock down. It was a major challenge for us to protect people from this pandemic. JSK made their efforts and distributed the relief packets among needy families. The condition of farmers were worst due to lockdown and they were unable to sell their agriculture produce and faced heavy loss during the covid period. JSK arranged the seeds and vegetable & fruits plant sapling to farmers of our target area. This year we supported more than 680 farmers. It really helped the farmers by cultivating the cash crop for livelihood during the pandemic.

Livelihood was a major challenges for families and women tried to contribute for income generation activity with their skills. JSK organized training to women under our skills development program and link with livelihood activities. We trained the women on sewing and stitching and involved them in income generating activities. We also promoted fish production activities in 30 ponds of 22 villages of Mandu, Tatijharia, Churchu and Gomia Blocks of Jharkhand. More than 280 families are getting benefits from fish production activity.

This year we also supported women empowerment activity by promotion of SHG groups and linked with bank for credit facilities. They regularly save the money in group and take loan from group as per their needs. Some groups also received loan from the bank.

All these programs have been possible due to regular and generous support from donor, community, government officer, CSR, individuals, to whom I, on behalf of JSK, extend heartfelt gratitude and Thanks. The hard work, dedication and commitment of project staffs, volunteers and board members are warmly acknowledged.

Since then the organization is working with an approach of integrated development of rural mass and creating awareness in the rural areas. The vision is to establish a self reliant, exploitation free, healthy and just society; where no one remains hungry, unemployed, illiterate and exploited. JSK believes that the elements of development and the resources requires to develop a society lies in the society. The need is to identify those, mobilize them and facilitate with opportunities

to prosper. JSK also believes that peoples participation, proper utilization of knowledge skill and experiences of people are never be less importance and valuable than modern knowledge.

GOONJ INITIATIVES :



COVID RELIEF PROGRAM

Covid pandemic is one of the major challenges for worldwide people. In our country we are very much affected. The positive cases were increasing day by day. The people were suffering from lack of treatment and food scarcity. Many people lost their nearest and dearest family member and lost their livelihood. The condition turned into worst in 3-4 months in the beginning of financial year. Many migrant labourers came back to their villages due to lock down in the country.

JSK realized the need of people during covid and started the food kit distribution program. We distributed more than 2015 food kits among needy families of Tatijhariya, Bishnugarh, Sadar and Gomia blocks of Jharkhand by the support of GOONJ New Delhi, HOXSA- Hazaribag, Old Xaviers Students Associations, Individual Donors. We arranged the food items in dry ration kit for one month to each family.

Dignity for Work/RAHAT



Under the program, villagers constructed 40kms village road in different places of Sadar Chatra, Churchu Hazaribag and Gomia Bokaro by support of GOONJ New Delhi under the program Dignity for Work/RAHAT. Water crisis is major issues in villages during the summer time. Therefore villagers contributed their labour for making 18 small ponds in their villages of Gomia block of Boakro district. We also arranged the food kit to 30 families who were victim of elephant herd destroyed the houses in villages Liklahi, PurnaPani and Piprabeda villages of Churchu block.

LIVELIHOOD PROMOTION



Livelihood was a major challenge for villagers. Under the livelihood support, we arranged the seeds and vegetable crops sapling & fruits plants sapling for farmers of Gomia block of Bokaro district and Tatijharia block of Hazaribag district. Total 150000 vegetables plant sapling among 150 farmers and 7458 fruit plants among 521 families were distributed during the period for livelihood generation by the support of GOONJ. We distributed fish spam for 30 ponds and 5 Fish nets with fish feed to the farmers of Gomia, Tatijharia and Mandu blocks. We provided support to small pigs to one women SHG group having 10 members in group and supported coal to one SHGs having 15 member of Bhelwapani village of Gomia block for making bricks.

ONGC INITIATIVES :

LIVELIHOOD PROMOTION THROUGH AGRICULTURE INPUTS



JSK works with farmers to promote livelihood. Promotion of livelihood through agriculture was the priority of the organization. JSK selected the farmers of Gomia block of Bokaro and provided the farm equipment including electric and diesel water pump and HDPE- High Density Polythene Pipe to farmers of 10 villages. It was supported by ONGC under ST/SC component plan. More than 789 farmers were benefited and doing the off season farming in 125 acres of land. The double cropping pattern of Rabi and Gamma crops have been started in this area. The farmers were also given seeds and technical support by the organization. The farmers selling their agricultural produce in local market and getting income from cash crops.

The project provided the generator set with sound system to the member of Tasha part at Bhauratand village of Gomia block Boakro district by the support of ONGC under ST/SC component.

JSK also supported the farmers by providing seeds and farm equipments with the support of NBJK Hazaribag. Under the program, we supported 215 farmers of Gomia block of Boakro district. We also provided the technical update and time to time agriculture expert meeting was organized under the project. The farmers are growing the vegetables for their livelihood

RENOVATION OF AWC

The first schooling of rural children in India start from Anganwadi center. Most of the villages have AWC center. JSK initiated the renovation of AWC centers by the support of ONGC under CSR activities with theme of Pradhan Mantri Expressional district. The 10 AWC centers of Sadar Rural block of Hazaribag were selected and renovated the building, were renovated, wall paintings and writings, provided the toys, playing kits and mats etc in each centers. The model AWC centers are motivating the parents to send their children in AWC. The Pictorial art and photos were made in each center. These are attracting the children retention.

LIVELIHOOD THROUGH SKILL DEVELOPMENT

JSK organize the poor women and provided the skills training to the women on sewing and stitching for better livelihood. The project was supported by ONGC Bokaro branch. The project provided 50 sewing machines to the trained women after completion of training. Total 50 women of different groups including ST- 23, SC-2 OBC-25 women took training for 6 months. 32 types of garments have been learnt by the women. The women are using their sewing skills and earning for their family. The average income of each family increased Rs. 3000-5000 per month by these activities.





COMMUNITY TOILET CONSTRUCTION UNDER SANITATION PROGRAM



Sanitation is a major issue in schools where children are studying. Community Toilet is one of the best option for school and public places. JSK constructed community toilets in Public High School Kuju where more than 1500 students are in school. Updated community toilets are constructed by the support of ONGC Bokaro under CSR activities. These toilets are used by the students as well as school teachers.

COMMUNITY HEALTH PROGRAM

Organization implemented the target intervention (TI) project at Garhwaa district of Jharkhand with the support of JSACS government of Jharkhand Ranchi. Total target were 600 FSW AND 10000 transit people in which we have covered 200 FSW and 485 transit people. The Project covers total 05 positive cases under the TI project. The project creates awareness about STI/HIV/AIDS among people and stake holders and develop understanding of safe sex among the stakeholders. The organizations works with FSWs. Referral services, regular counseling, linkages with ART Centers, training to ORW, road show etc were done during the year.

JSK organized the awareness campaign through organizing Canapé at Railway station and provide counseling and fulfill the demand by distribution of condoms. JSK also organized the free medical checkup camp for Sex worker on quarterly basis by the support of Prefer Public Providers and provided required medicine and counseling. JSK also refer to ART centre to positive sex

workers for better treatment and enroll for social benefits schemes.

AMBULANCE SERVICES

The organization is providing Ambulance services to the people of, Mandu -Rangarh district, Bishngarh and TatiJhariya in Hazaribag and Gomiya block of Bokaro district. 15 cases from Mandu, 5 cases from Bishnugarha, 7 cases from TatiJhariya and total 27 cases were provided medical van support with taking nominal fees. In case of



health emergency, people do not have access to any vehicle for the remotest villages of Bokaro and Hazaribagh Districts. As these villages are very remote and surrounded by forest areas. Private vehicle either avoid going or they demand very huge money. To avoid this situation, during the health emergency, the organization provides ambulance services to the poor and needy villagers. This service is of great assistance to the poor villagers especially

at night. Death during pregnancy, antenatal death, and post natal death is very common in Hazaribag. The villagers have no any other option to reach hospital for treatment. Ambulance is catering the need of pregnant women 24x7 to promote the institutional delivery also. Organization is very much thankful to MLA Mandu and MLA Gomiya for support this valuable work.



DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

We are associated with SAMMA ANS SWAYAM NETWORK for the purpose of minimizing the domestic violence and gender discrimination

During the year, organization has formed and strengthened 07Kishori group, 35 women Self HELP Group, in Tatijhariya Block. Sahiya, Anganwadi workers, PRI members, Local police station representatives were sensitized on the social issues. Regular meetings and counseling were done with victims and community as well. Organization is thankful to Srijan foundation Hazaribag for financial and technical support.

Women always play a key role in the family and society in creating livelihood activities. Keeping in view JSK organizes women from poor household to form self-help groups for saving and credit Purposes. In most of villages JSK begins work by promoting poor women's Self Help Groups, which is an informal association of 10 to 19 women to work together in a group. Various project teams have formed about 5 new SHGs during the year covering more than 55 members. Farm and nonfarm activities have been promoted among the SHGs. They trained on vermin compost, organic farming, goat rearing, Pig rearing and poultry farming.
